Safeguarding at Cwmaman Town Council

Cwmaman Town Council is committed to providing safe, welcoming and inclusive spaces for everyone in the community.

We recognise our responsibility to safeguard and promote the welfare of children, young people and adults at risk who may come into contact with our services, facilities and activities.

This includes:

- Play parks and open spaces
- The community centre and family events
- The bunkhouse and group accommodation
- The café and community facilities

The Council has a Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy and clear procedures for responding to safeguarding concerns in line with Welsh legislation and guidance.

These documents explain how safeguarding concerns are recognised, reported and managed.
